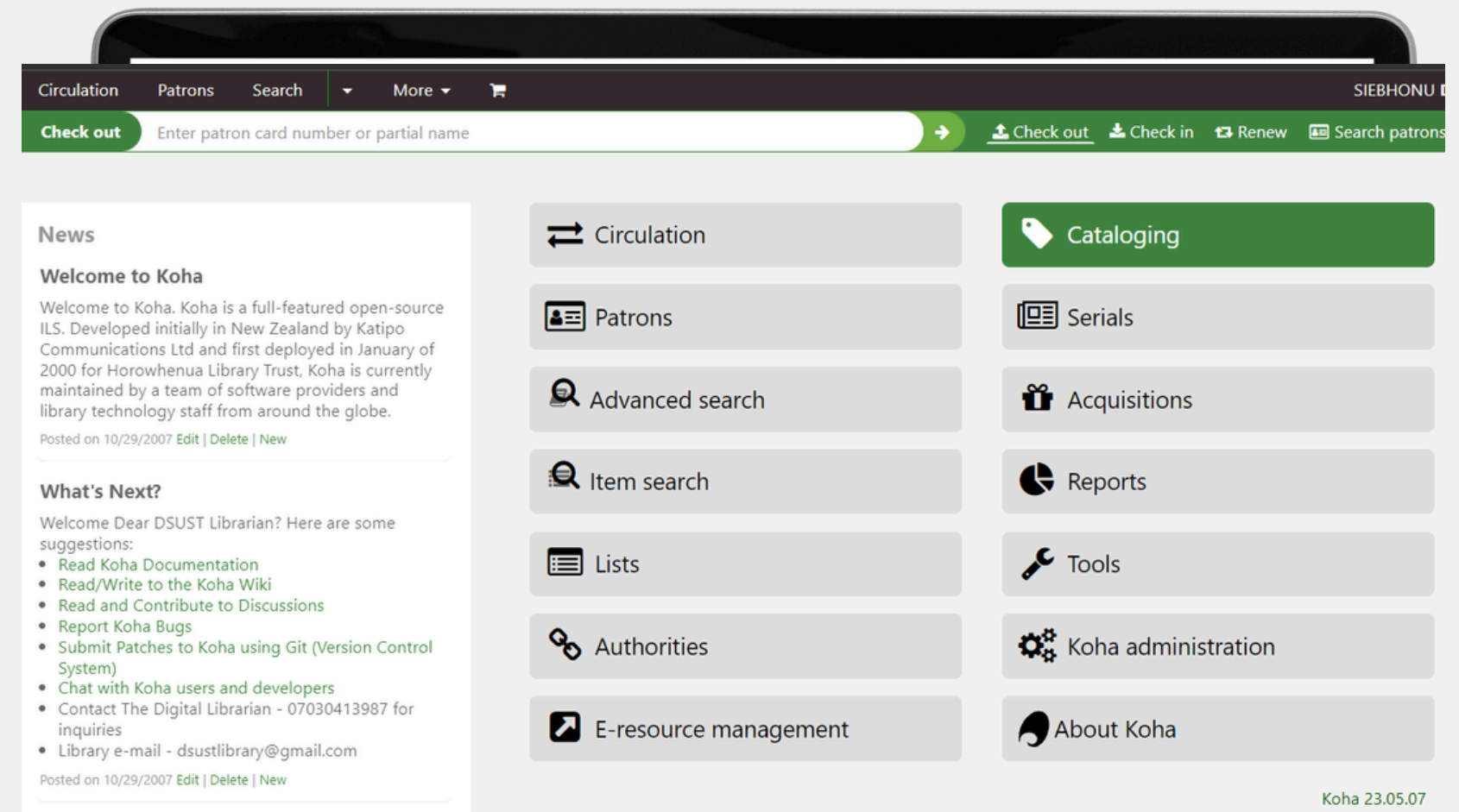

BENEFITS SO FAR



Improved Patron Service

Staff workload is reduced which creates room for more patrons' oriented services. Patrons are able to reserve books remotely



Faster Cataloguing

automated cataloguing standards - Machine Readable Catalogue (MARC), and copy cataloguing to the rescue of Librarians



It saves Time

Koha is very economical especially when considering alternatives to commercially available Software you can rely on.

1. Migrating from NewGenLib Software
2. Inadequate Power Supply
3. Apathy on the part of Library Staff
